ACE Soccer Club Code of Conduct

ACE Soccer Club expects every player, parent, and coach to represent the club with integrity, on and off the field. By accepting a roster spot, all members agree to the standards below. Violations may result in suspension or removal from the club.

Players

- Show up on time, prepared, and ready to compete every training and game.
- Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, and referees with respect at all times.
- No trash talk, profanity, or taunting on the field, sideline, or in the locker room.
- Accept coaching feedback without arguing. Address concerns privately with the coach.
- Represent the club outside soccer — in school, on social media, and in your community.
- No alcohol, tobacco, vaping, or drugs at any club function.
- Respect club property and the training facility. Pick up after yourself.
- If injured, communicate honestly with the coach and follow the medical staff's plan.

Parents and Guardians

- Cheer positively for the team — never berate players, coaches, referees, or opponents.
- Leave coaching to the coaches during training and games. Trust the process.
- Concerns about playing time, position, or strategy: schedule a meeting with the coach. Do not approach a coach immediately before, during, or after a game.
- Pay registration and team fees on time through the Spond app.
- Get your player to training and games on time, in full club kit.
- Communicate absences in advance through Spond or directly to the coach.
- Model good sportsmanship — your child watches you more than anyone else.

Coaches

- Hold a current SafeSport certification and applicable USSF / state licensing.
- Develop every player on the roster — not just the strongest ones.
- Communicate clearly with parents about expectations, attendance, and selection.
- Never use degrading or abusive language toward players or opponents.
- Set the tone for sportsmanship; address opposing-team and referee interactions with calm.
- Report any safety, conduct, or wellbeing concerns to the Director of Coaching immediately.
- Follow the concussion protocol — when in doubt, sit them out.

Discipline Process

Minor infractions are handled directly by the coach. Repeated or serious violations (physical altercation, racial or discriminatory conduct, theft, substance abuse, abuse of officials) are reviewed by the Director of Coaching and may result in immediate dismissal from the club without refund. ACE Soccer Club reserves the right to remove any player, parent, or coach whose conduct is contrary to the values of the club.
